

An Open Challenge to the SPS Immana Boat

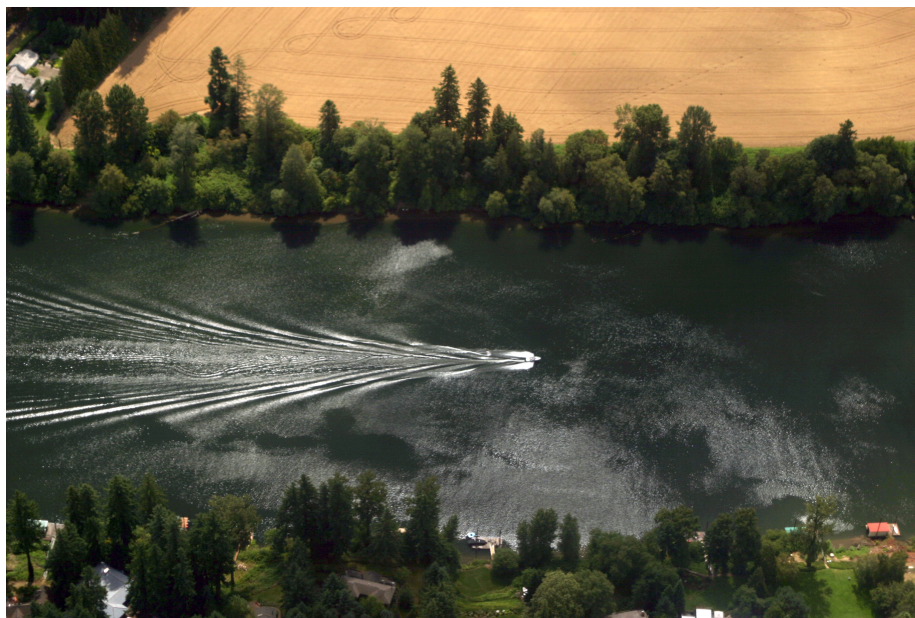


Figure 1: Immana Boat, available at: <http://tinyurl.com/immanaboat>
